STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Nighttime Residence

Missing one or more of the following traits: fixed, regular, and adequate

Fixed, regular, and adequate; Living in the same place each night in a safe & sufficient space

Doubled Up

Due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason

Mutual decision made to live together for mutual benefit

Hotels, Motels, Trailer Parks, Campgrounds

Due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations

Due to family choice; e.g., when permanently housed parent accepts a new job and the family stays temporarily in a hotel, RV, etc. until they obtain new permanent housing

Housing Type

A place not meant for living; e.g., porch, barn, storage unit, streets, car, etc.

Substandard housing; e.g., unsafe, not up to code, etc.
(Contact district liaison for guidance)


